A Devolution Revolution. We are going to allow local government to keep the rates they collect from business. All £26 billion of business rates will be kept by councils instead of being sent to Whitehall. Local areas will be able to cut business rates as much as they like to win new jobs. This is the biggest transfer of power to our local government in living memory.

Bringing in the National Living Wage. Next April sees the National Living Wage introduced, giving up to 6 million working people a well-deserved pay rise. Rising to £9 an hour by 2020 and combined with our on-going raising of the tax-free allowance, the UK will move away from a low-wage, high-tax and high-welfare economy, to a higher-wage, lower-tax and lower-welfare society.

A Major Plan To Get Britain Building. We will set up an independent National Infrastructure Commission to work out what the country needs to build for its future. It will hold any Government to account if it fails to deliver. We are also sweeping away planning rules on brownfield sites and creating half a dozen British Wealth Funds to invest billions in British infrastructure.

**Charles Petts:
Broadfield South Feedback**

The long-awaited improvements to **Broadfield Barton** are planned to be completed by next spring. Originally agreed in January 2014 by the previous Conservative-run Council and with a local exhibition held back then, the subsequent delay under the Labour-run Council has been disappointing but it is great that we are now starting to see real progress once again.

Back in 2013, we had the aspiration and vision for the **Barton** to be improved and be made to look and feel much safer for the local **Broadfield** community. We authorised £300,000 from Crawley Borough Council for the project and secured a further £145,000 funding from local stakeholders and businesses.

It is disappointing that on Labour's watch, **Morrisons** shut up shop and left the Barton, leaving the Council to pick up the tab for the withdrawal of their contribution, but we believe the Council were right to make up the shortfall as the Barton is the heart of Broadfield and we are determined for the **Barton** to be successful. We already opened the Community Hub at **Broadfield Library** in 2013 and by next May we will see:

- Improvements to the CCTV system
- The repaving of the precinct surface
- Replacement of the existing canopies
- Replacement of the under canopy lighting
- Painting of the existing canopy columns
