■ Since Crawley went to the polls in May, which saw Henry Smith re-elected as Crawley's MP and Conservative Councillors elected to Crawley Borough Council, our plan locally to 'Secure Crawley's Future' continues to work, providing real opportunities for Crawley.

Crawley Borough Council now has the closest ever political balance. Back in May, Crawley elected 9 Conservative and 3 Labour Councillors, taking us very close to control, with 18 Conservative Councillors to Labour's 19 in total.

A Devolution Revolution. We are going to allow local government to keep the rates they collect from business. All £26 billion of business rates will be kept by councils instead of being sent to Whitehall. Local areas will be able to cut business rates as much as they like to win new jobs. This is the biggest transfer of power to our local government in living memory.

Bringing in the National Living Wage. Next April sees the National Living Wage introduced, giving up to 6 million working people a well-deserved pay rise. Rising to £9 an hour by 2020 and combined with our on-going raising of the tax-free allowance, the UK will move away from a low-wage, high-tax and high-welfare economy, to a higher-wage, lower-tax and lower-welfare society.

A Major Plan To Get Britain Building. We will set up an independent National Infrastructure Commission to work out what the country needs to build for its future. It will hold any Government to account if it fails to deliver. We are also sweeping away planning rules on brownfield sites and creating half a dozen British Wealth Funds to invest billions in British infrastructure.

Kevin Hall: Langley Green Update

Tushmore Roundabout

We are pleased that the work undertaken to replace the traffic signal loops on the **Tushmore Roundabout** is scheduled for early January. We have shared in the frustration of residents in the delay of this work, which could not happen at the same time as the work that Southern Gas Networks were undertaking.

Large traffic volumes will always be a factor in congestion but we have been pressing for the best possible sequencing efficiency for the traffic lights, so as to minimise queues and **traffic jams** at the roundabout and on the **A23**. We will monitor the situation and feed back to West Sussex Highways.

Kevin Comments

We share residents concerns about the parking difficulties in Langley Green. Whilst out and about in the area, Kevin has spoken to many residents who have expressed frustration at vehicles having to double-park, especially on bus routes such as **Stagelands** and **Martyrs Avenue**. This has led to congestion and delayed buses.

Kevin comments "Why hasn't something been done to rectify this? People may ask what Councillors have been doing all these years to improve the parking situation in Langley Green? It is a great shame that more hasn't been done to try and resolve important local issues such as this".

Kevin is also deeply concerned by the increase in the levels of **litter and fly-tipping** in our area. **Hedges, verges, parks** and **open spaces** seem to have an increasing amount of unsightly litter plaguing our wonderful neighbourhood. This also goes for **dog fouling**. Kevin feels some Councillors could do more locally. Get in Touch with Kevin if you have an issue you would like him to take up and get some action on.
